

Barring Key Club, activities such as science research, varsity soccer, mentorship at Hofstra University, musical endeavors, and involvement in multiple honor societies, such as Tri-M, Rho Kappa, and English honor society. Demonstrates a wide range of capabilities while simultaneously being an active part of Key Club. Participation in these activities fostered analytical thinking, attention to detail, civic awareness, and sustained service skills. Science research encouraged initiative through real-world application, exemplified by the creation of a proposal designed to promote inclusion for the hearing impaired and strengthen both critical and logical reasoning. Alongside scientific knowledge, honor societies also further cultivated intellectual growth.

Leadership Skills Inside / Outside of Key Club

Active participation across academic, artistic, athletic, and service organizations has shaped a well-rounded extracurricular profile. Membership in musical ensembles such as Global Jazz Ensemble, Science Research engagement and even athletic involvement which includes varsity soccer participation and varsity softball team management. Science research involvement extends to multiple regional and state fairs, symposiums, and competitions. Creative expression, teamwork, and community service remain consistent themes across activities, complemented by over 300 verified volunteer hours through school and community initiatives.

Science research honors include 3rd Place at the South America Women Asian Alliance Science Fair (2025), the AP Scholar Award (2025), the Key Step-Up Award (2025), the Underdog Award (2025), and recognition for 100+ service hours in Key Club (2025). 
