FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS IT AND WHY SHOULD I GO?

Key Club International Convention (ICON) is a celebration of all things Key Club! Join hundreds of Key Clubbers and advisors from across the globe to recognize incredible service efforts, participate in personal and leadership development sessions, determine the future direction of Key Club, and elect the next International Board.

WHERE AND WHEN IS IT?

The New York District will be heading to the Hilton Anaole from June 30th through July 7th.

HOW MUCH IS IT AND WHAT IS INCLUDED?

This year, the tour cost is \$1,785.00 and includes round trip airfare, all ground transportation, seven nights hotel accommodations (quads), admission to Six Flags Over Texas, a dude ranch excursion to experience horseback riding, lasso lessons, archery, line dancing, and a scrumptious BBQ lunch, visits to the Sixth Floor Museum, the Dallas Museum of Illusions, the interactive Perot Museum of Nature & Science, the challenge of Escapology, our New York District dinner to Medieval Times, most meals, pins to trade, and everything ICON (registration, workshops, entertainment, and a dance)!!

WHEN SHOULD I REGISTER AND WHAT IS THE PAYMENT SCHEDULE?

You should register as soon as possible as the tour price is guaranteed only for the first 25 people traveling from New York-LaGuardia and the first 15 people traveling from Albany. **A deposit of \$600.00 is due by Friday, April 17th, a second payment of \$600.00 will be due by Friday, May 1st, and the final \$585.00 payment is due by Friday, May 15th.** Additional registrants will be subject to flight availability and will be responsible for any airfare differential. (Deposits are non-refundable.)

HOW WILL WE GET TO DALLAS?

New York District has secured special group airfare departing in the morning on Tuesday, June 30th from New York-LaGuardia International Airport and Albany International Airport and returning on Tuesday, July 7th.

No, all New York Key Clubbers wishing to attend must register as part of the District Tour. The total package price is based on all participants on the same itinerary; therefore we cannot accept airline miles, hotel points, or any other form of payment to reduce the tour cost.
